Schedule for the Day:

8:30 – 8:50	Registration/Arrival
9:00 – 11:30	Rehearsal (Elem. Honors will be in MS Theater, MS Honors in H.S. Auditorium)
11:30 – 1:00	LUNCH – on your own. There are plenty of places to eat right on Franklin Road, or students can bring a lunch and eat in a designated place on campus. Hopefully, it will be nice weather, and kids can eat outside.
1:00 – 4:30	Rehearsal (MS Honors will be in MS Theater, Elem. Honors in H.S. Auditorium)
4:30 – 6:30	DINNER/DRESS – on your own. There will be two rooms (boys/girls) set aside for changing rooms. These rooms are not huge, however, so students need to take care of their belongings!
7:00	CONCERT at F.R.A in the MS Theater.

Concert Attire:

BLACK pants or skirt (talk about appropriate skirt length - knee or lower), and WHITE button-down shirt or blouse. Please have students avoid casual attire... this is a performance!! If the attire is a problem for any of your students, please ask them to get as close to dress code as possible.

T-Shirts:

The T-shirts that you ordered will be at F.R.A. by March 2nd (we hope!). Someone will be available during the morning rehearsal to hand out your shirts and collect your fees. PLEASE PLAN TO PAY for your shirts that day! School OR director's checks are accepted – made out to MTVA. (Remember: Cost of T-shirt is \$10, but add \$1.75 for any Adult **XXL** shirt!)

Suggestions from our Clinician:

- 1) Please have students number their measures in ALL of their pieces.
- 2) Students should come prepared and know their music. It will be VERY difficult to bring 141 kids together in one day if students are unprepared.
- 3) IF YOU ARE HAVING TROUBLE GETTING "The Wish", please let me know. I will fax a copy to you and you can make copies and begin teaching to students. JW Pepper is contacting the publisher to see if we can legally make copies!

Behavior:
