# MTVA Board Meeting Minutes October 14th 2008 5:15 p.m. St Cecilia Academy

### I. Call to Order

## III. Reports

**David Spencer, Treasurer,** submitted the Treasurer's Report from Sept 7-Oct. 14, 2008.

Connie Fuller, Middle School Mass Chair, received a second bill from David Lipscomb for use of their facility. This additional expense will be considered when looking into future use of Allen Arena and budgeting.

### IV. Unfinished Business

Lia Holland, Mid-State Auditions Chair/Technologist, readdressed the issue of the interpretation of incomplete and incorrect application fee.

A discussion among the board led a motion from the board.

The board moved to define "incomplete and incorrect" in a way that every time a director contacts MTVA in any way, to make a change to a submitted application before the deadline, they will incur a \$25 fee. Any changes to the application after the deadline will incur late fees as described in the handbook.

### V. New Business

**David Spencer, Treasurer** brought to the board the issue of transportation costs for adjudicators, clinicians and accompanists. Keeping the idea that gas prices are in fluctuation, the board discussed ideas to fairly reimburse individuals without turning reimbursement into a profit.

A motion was made to reimburse with receipts and gas costs plus 50% (Jackson, Kolwyck)

The motion passed.

A motion was made to determine when MTVA will reimburse individuals traveling out of town. An "out of town" label was given to any individual traveling a distance of 25 miles one way or 50 miles round trip minimum from the event site. These individuals will be considered for reimbursement.

The motion passed.

A discussion on the duties of the treasurer took place between all members of the board. No motions were made and the topic was tabled to a future meeting.
