

MTVA Elementary Mass Choral Festival

General Information

- The Middle Tennessee Vocal Association (MTVA) Elementary Mass Choir is one-day event for students in grade 4 – 6.
- There is no individual audition to participate.
- Generally, a music teacher will register their elementary choir for this event.
- Each school's music teacher must be a member of MTVA and MENC to participate.
- There are two sessions for the day:
 - 9:30 – 12:30 rehearsal
 - 1:30 – 4:30 rehearsal
 - 6:30 p.m. concert for both groups

- Be sure to make note of the event date and the registration deadline.
- ALL registration is done online; click "Forms" to find the appropriate event.
- If your school code is not listed on the website, please notify the MTVA president.
- As you register online, a copy is automatically emailed to the event chairperson. It is suggested you print off copy of your registration, make a copy and mail it along with the appropriate fees to the current treasurer.
- Applications and fees must be postmarked/dated by the deadline date or late fees will be incurred. Please refer to the handbook for late fee policy.
- This event is limited to 300-310 students per session due to size of performance venue.
