Mid State Rules/Attire

- *Each student must bring a pencil.
- *No gum, food, or drink allowed in rehearsal. Bottled water is allowed.
- *No cell phone use allowed in rehearsal.
- *No illegal photocopies of music allowed. Please bring your music in the black folder that was provided for you.
- *Tardiness will not be tolerated! Be on time for roll call so rehearsal can begin early.
- *Participation in Mid State is required for All State.
- *Absences/tardiness put one's Mid State and All State status in jeopardy.
- *Dress code for rehearsals-follow your school's dress code policy.

**Dress Code for Concerts

Women-ankle length black dress with sleeves, or an ankle length black skirt with a black top of complementary fabric, black shoes no more than 2 inches in height, optional modest jewelry. No long earrings or large choker necklaces. **Men**-white tux shirt or white long-sleeved dress shirt with black bow tie, black tux or dress pants, black dress shoes, black socks. No jackets, vests, black jeans, or tennis shoes.
